FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



1

What is the program structure? Will the program be virtual or in-person?

The program will be a 40-hour hybrid program. Some parts of the program may be at various locations depending on if it is coursework, laboratories, or clinical rotations

Where can I complete prerequisite coursework?

Prerequisite coursework can often be completed through accredited colleges, universities, or approved online programs. City Colleges of San Francisco has many options for these courses. MA/PC pathways candidate Medical Terminology and Anatomy & Physiology courses will apply towards the prerequisites.

Are there any exceptions to the prerequisites?

No, the prerequisites are required. You can have a degree that is an Associates in any field or a degree higher, like Bachelors or Masters. Copy of diploma and transcripts from the required coursework will be required.

Do I have to finish my prerequisite coursework before I apply or before the program begins?

If you show that you are in the process of taking the prerequisite courses, you may be conditionally accepted into the program. The condition being that you complete the course with an acceptable grade before the start of the Radiology program.

How will I know if I am eligible for tuition or salary subsidies?

This will be determined on application review. We encourage students to focus on earning the prerequisites and providing a strong application. The funding and other needs support will be reviewed and determined afterwards.

Where can I find more information on how to apply and whether I qualify for tuition assistance?

The application will open in October 2025. More details about the application process and tuition assistance will be available at that time. Stay tuned for updates or reach out to the program team for additional guidance.

When is the next chance of applying?

Cohort 1 starts in June 2026 and is an 18-month program. Cohort 2 will begin January 2028. Applications for Cohort 2 *may* be released around February 2027.
