PROGRAM STRUCTURE:



18-month full-time program in **Diagnostic Imaging**
Cohort 1 begins: June 2026

Curriculum includes coursework, exams, labs, and clinical experiences. Students participate in academic and leadership training that occur online, at UCSF, or at partner locations.

Ideal Candidates

- 1 **Graduates** of UCSF's Career Pathways Initiative (Practice Coordinator or Medical Assistant roles) who are employed at UCSF*.
- 2 **Any UCSF Employee.***
- 3 **External to UCSF.**

*UCSF employees, applying to this program, may be eligible for tuition waiver and salary subsidies based on formal admissions review. Incumbent workers should

- Complete prerequisite courses
- Receive manager approval (via email) for participation into this program.
- Receive "Meets Expectations" or higher on most recent performance review

Prerequisites

- Associate's degree or higher (in any field)
- Complete prerequisite coursework:
 - Medical Terminology
 - Anatomy and Physiology course
 - College Algebra or higher
- A minimum GPA of 2.5
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Be at least 18 years old at the time of matriculation
- Clear ARRT eligibility regarding any prior felonies or misdemeanors, if applicable ([Link here](#)).
